Food Safety & Standards Regulations, 2011- The New Mandate

As a part of Tea Board's initiative in preparing organizations associated with tea business to face the upcoming challenges of Food Safety and Standards Act 2006, Tea Board in association with CII FACE is going to conduct a series of Awareness Programmes *FSSR, 2011- The New mandate* in different tea belts of India.

As per the act, all Food Establishments and Manufacturing Units have to procure either Licence or get them registered with FSSAI as per their turnover, prior to 4th August 2012. It will thus be important for all food organizations to be aware about the challenges they will be facing with the enforcement of Food Safety & Standards Act (FSSA) which has come into force, from Aug 5, 2011.

Persons associated with all sorts of business related to tea like Manufacturer, trader, BLF, packers, Blenders, warehouses etc.
