

OFFICE MEMORANDUM NO.53/2015

Shri Ranjan Das, Dy. Director of Tea Development, attached to Board's Office at Guwahati, will attain the age of 60 years on 31-01-2016. In terms of By-Law 30 of the Tea Board, By Laws, 1955 (as amended from time to time) read in conjunction with FR 56(a), he will superannuate from the services of the Board with effect from the afternoon of 31-01-2016.

2. Shri Das may avail himself of all kinds of leave he is entitled to under rules before the date of his superannuation. Earned Leave for more than 300 days will not, however, be granted to him at a time, if spent within India.
