

Tea Board to establish separate Development Directorate for small tea growers

Tea Board organized a small tea growers' convention at Jalpaiguri on 27th July, 2012. This was the third convention in the series of conventions being organized by the Board. The first two conventions were held in the month of May and June at Sonitpur and Golaghat districts of Assam.

The purpose of the conventions is to create awareness amongst the small tea growers about the importance of their collectivization for moving up in the value chain and also the various support measures available from Tea Board to the growers for improving productivity and quality of green leaf for better price realisation.
